We will be singing these at the library and our Nativity performance.</p>	<p>*NUMERACY* <u>I am learning to count backwards.</u> Practise counting backwards aloud with an adult. You can count objects or count numbers alternately.</p> <p><i>Cool-</i> Numbers from 10. <i>Hot-</i> Numbers from 20. <i>Spicy-</i> Numbers from 30.</p> <p>*LITERACY* <u>I am learning to read and write tricky words.</u> <i>Cool</i> - When reading a story with an adult, work together to read the tricky words in the story. <i>Hot</i> - Identify tricky words in books you read with an adult from the list provided. <i>Spicy</i> - Identify tricky words in books you read with an adult without referring to the sheet provided. You may wish to tally the words you find.</p>
