<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>*LISTENING &amp; TALKING*</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>We are learning to present information to an audience</u></b></p> <p>Create an information poster about Autumn to present to the class. This could be about animals getting ready to hibernate or how the trees change at this time of year.</p> <p>Ensure the poster has a; title, is easy and clear to read and attractively presented using colour and pictures.</p> <p>Children are also welcome to bring in items for our nature table to share signs of Autumn.</p> <p><b><u>Challenge: Can you research why the leaves change colour or about a particular animal's behaviour during Autumn.</u></b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>*SPELLING*</u></b></p> <p>Practise this month's spelling words using the Spellwell activity sheet using blue vowel or rainbow letters. These spelling patterns have been practised in school.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>*HEALTH &amp; WELLBEING*</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>I am learning to express my feeling and ways to manage them</u></b></p> <p>Create a page for our class treasure book of all the things that make you feel happy and treasured. You could place a picture or photograph of yourself in the centre and draw or collage special things around this, such as family members, pets, or special memories. We will use these to create a class book that we can share together. This is linked to our whole school work on resilience.</p>

Can you find a word the author has used and improve it? For example instead of big the author could have used giant, colossal, gigantic.</p> <p>Please share these with the class.</p> <p><b><u>Challenge : Can you use a thesaurus or go online to find examples.</u></b></p>	<p>MATHS: <b><u>I am learning to tile 2D shapes.</u></b></p> <p>Select 2D shapes that you know will tile.
