<u>*Literacy*</u> <u>We are learning to create a set of instructions.</u> Following the success of Health and Sports week, create a set of instructions to introduce a new skill, game or activity to help other people. This could include relaxation techniques, a sport or game to teach the P1s. Think about it step-by-step to make sure your instructions are clear.	<u>*SPELLING*</u> Complete 'Spell Well' activities using spelling words overleaf. <u>*READING*</u> Why not go to the local library and check out a new type of book or magazine? They also have lots of e-books available for free!	<u>Art</u> <u>We are learning to listen and respond to music</u> Listen to a piece of music and draw or write down your response to it (i.e. your thoughts and feelings). This could be done as a mindmap, painting, list or any other way you choose. Remember to note down the title and artist of the piece of music.
<u>Enterprise</u> <u>We are learning to run a business</u> Choose a business that you have heard of that does something a little bit different! This could be a big business or an up-and-coming project that hasn't been fully discovered yet. Find out some interesting facts about your chosen business to share with the class.	<hr/> <u>*NUMERACY*</u> 1. Keep practising your times tables. 2. The accuracy of your adding and subtracting within 100.	<u>*SCIENCE*</u> <u>We are learning to create a chemical reaction.</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring in a clean and empty washing up bottle and a newspaper. • Can you guess what you might be doing with them? Come to school with your ideas.
<u>*MATHS*</u> <u>We are learning to create and solve equations.</u> Create your own picture equations for someone else to solve. It should include an answer sheet so they can check it. For example:	If you have the opportunity, log on to your Sumdog account and practise your skills.	<u>*WIDER ACHIEVEMENT - JASS*</u> By now you should have completed at least two sections of your JASS folder.
